

## **Dimovski Vlado**

Professor of Management and Organization at the Faculty of Economics, University of Ljubljana, Slovenia



Vlado Dimovski is a full professor of management and organizational theory at the Management and organization department, at the University of Ljubljana, Faculty of Economics in Slovenia.

He received his B.A. degree in Economics at the University of Ljubljana, the B.A. degree in Philosophy at the University of Ljubljana, the M.A. degree in Economics at University of Ljubljana, and the Ph.D. degree in Management and Finance at Cleveland State University.

His academic research interests cover modern management theory, organizational learning, learning organization, competitiveness, strategizing information technology, non-profit management, corporate strategy, investment policy and labor markets.

He is author of various books, book chapters, and research studies, including Slovenian and international issues. He has published about 200 articles in applied and academic journals.

He currently teaches and researches at the various universities and institutions. He was a visiting scholar at universities in the United States and Europe. He had lectured at universities and conducted workshops for managers in several countries.

Besides his academic career he has also rich consulting experience. We has been advising companies, international institutions, and governments on the issues of strategic issues, labor market, and the EU-related projects since 1995. In period 1995-1995 he was also the State Secretary for Industry in the Government of Slovenia, the president of the Centre for International Competitiveness of Slovenia (1997-2005), the Minister of Labor, Family and Social Affairs (2000-2004).

He has received many scientific and professional awards, such as the Beta Gamma Sigma Award (1992), Harvard Directory of Scholars (1993), Who is Who (1999), Slovenian National Swimming Association Award (2001), Distinguished Slovenian Gold Management Award (2001) and Who is Who Statesmen (2004).
