Chairman of the Strategic Management Department, Professor at the School of Management and Director of the Executive MBA program at Warsaw University



Krzysztof Obloj is a Professor at the School of Management at Warsaw University, where he is the Chairman of the Strategic Management Department. He is also the Director of the Executive MBA program developed and run jointly by the University of Warsaw and the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign.

Professor Obloj is visiting professor of strategy and international management at several Universities and Schools of Management or Business in Europe and the United States. Most recently he has taught at the University of Illinois in the US, ESCP-EAP in France and Bodo School of Management in Norway.

Professor Obloj is very extensively published. He is the author and co-author of more than 80 scientific articles and books. Recently he has published two books in the US: Systems management: a global perspective (with S. Cavaleri) and Winning: Lessons from high performing organizations (with D. Cushman and A.K.Kozminski). His last two books published in Poland (Successful strategies, 1998 and Business strategy: developing a competitive advantage, 2000) have already had several editions.

He has an extensive hands-on experience as a consultant and member of numerous supervisory boards. Most recently he consulted to GlaxoSmithKline, Asea Brown Boveri, Orlen and Lukas Bank on issues of strategy, corporate patterns and cultural integration. For several years 1995, 1996, 1998 and 2000, he was recognized as the best executive MBA teacher.
