Dr Walravens is Professor Emeritus of Economic Sociology at the University of Technology, Delft, the Netherlands where he also served as the dean of the Faculty of Philosophy and Social Sciences. He received his PhD from the University of Technology, Twente, the Netherlands and served as faculty member at the Free University of Amsterdam.

Since 1993 Dr. Walravens is Academic Director of the Presidents' MBA Program at the IEDC – Bled School of Management and since 2001 a member of the Senate of Faculty of Postgraduate Studies at the same institution. He teaches the courses of Corporate Governance in MBA and General Management Programs at IEDC – Bled School of Management. He is author of five books and more than 90 articles. As UNDP/ILO consultant he was active in several countries with economies in development or transition, dealing mainly with privatization issues.

Arnold Walravens is Chairman of the Supervisory Board of Eureko B.V., and member or chairman of eight other supervisory boards, including those of large multinationals like Wolters Kluwer, CSM and RABO Bank.
